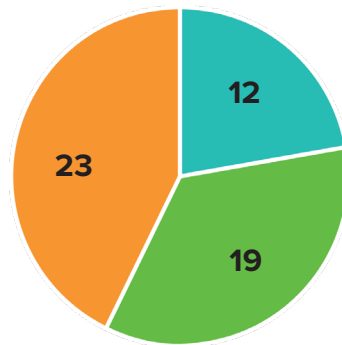


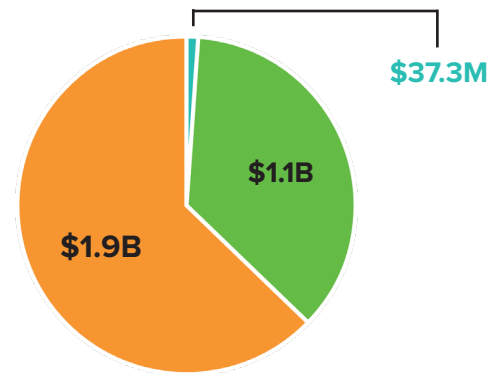

MAY TOP TRANSACTIONS

Oisin Biotechnologies Seattle biotech startup Oisín Biotechnologies has raised a \$5M seed round. It's currently developing preclinical therapies that target and kill damaged cells that have been biologically turned off or are "senescent" and supposed to die ([GeekWire](#)).

AVM Biotechnology raised \$4.43M in venture funding from undisclosed investors (Pitchbook).

Pattern Computer raised \$4.1M in Series A funding from undisclosed investors (Pitchbook).

OTHER TRENDS & HIGHLIGHTS

HDT Bio, a developer of immunotherapies for oncology and infectious diseases, announced the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases of the US National Institutes of Health has awarded the company a three-year, \$2.9M grant to develop an HIV-1 RNA vaccine with its proprietary Lipid InOrganic Nanoparticle delivery system ([Bloomberg](#)).

Dynamk Capital, a venture fund providing early stage and growth capital to innovative Life Science Industrials companies, today announced the final closing of its first fund, Dynamk Life Sciences Fund L.P. bringing the firm's total assets under management to \$65M ([Dynamk Capital](#)).

Seagen Bothell-based Seagen has not only landed on the 10th annual global Pharmaceutical Innovation Index for the first time, but came in at No. 4, beating out pharma giants like Pfizer, Merck & Co., and Johnson & Johnson ([Puget Sound Business Journal](#)).
